License Required: Possession of a certificate of registration as a professional engineer in the State of Hawaii.

Knowledge of: Civil engineering principles and practices; modern methods and practices used in the preparation of plans, specifications, estimates and reports; a sufficient knowledge of surveying and of construction principles and practices to be able to relate engineering design to these functions; structural, mechanical, electrical and sanitary engineering principles; principles and practice of supervision.

Ability to: Plan, organize, and direct the work of engineering and technical employees in construction and inspection activities; analyze stresses and determine the required foundation and structural features; conduct engineering studies and prepare technical reports and correspondence.

Health and Physical Conditions:

Persons seeking appointment to positions in this class must meet the health and

physical condition standards deemed necessary and proper for the performance of the duties.
